This special meeting was conducted electronically because an in-person meeting was impractical given social distancing guidelines set forth by the US Center for Disease Control.

This special meeting was opened with a roll call. Troy Bauder, Jen Jenson, Derek Knobloch, Scott Lee, and Justin Metzger were present. Supt. Kreman and Principals Jiskoot and Snyder were also in attendance.

Motion # 2803

Moved by Bauder and seconded by Knobloch to approve the agenda. Motion carried, all members voting "yes".

Supt. Kreman spoke to the Board about the Governor's School Closure extension.

Kreman explained that districts now have three learning opportunities while school is closed. They can be:

- No Continuous Learning
- Voluntary Educational Enrichment Activities
- Required Educational Services

Kreman said that he is recommending that the District move forward with Voluntary Activities. Principals Jiskoot and Snyder explained what those activities would look like.

Kreman said that, following discussions with administrators throughout the State, he is recommending that classified and certified staff members continue to be paid by the District through the school closure extension date.

Justin Metzger left the meeting at 7:34 pm.

Kreman finished with some discussion of agenda items for the next meeting and limiting access to the school during the closure.
