# **GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS**

<u>Cooperative Farmers Elevator Scholarship</u> – Cooperative Farmers Elevator is offering three 2-year full tuition sponsorships to any high school senior pursuing an Associates of Applied Science Ag degree at a participating technical college. CFE supports deserving students who have a passion for agriculture, a desire to attain their educational goals and driven to succeed to their fullest ability. <u>Cooperative Farmers Elevator Scholarship</u> – the Coop Farmers Elevator is also offering 5 (five) \$1000 scholarships to high school seniors pursuing an agricultural-related major at a technical school or college this fall. Application requirements are to complete 2 separate essays
