GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Siouxland Officials Association Scholarship – the Siouxland Officials Association is sponsoring five \$1000 scholarships to graduating seniors. These seniors would have been leaders in their class as it relates to great sportsmanship on and off the playing field. Applications can be found in Miss Mulder’s office. **Deadline is March 24.**

Logan Kruse Memorial Scholarship - We all remember Logan Kruse as a special young man. Though his time with us was far too short, Logan made a significant impact on those around him. His infectious smile and knack for including others are but a small part of the way in which Logan made West Lyon a better place. Logan’s parents, grandparents, family members, and community wish to honor his memory by supporting a scholarship in his name...the Logan Kruse Memorial Scholarship.

CRITERIA: The family’s wishes, with regard to Logan’s Scholarship are:

1. Students selected are to have shown an honest effort in their studies at West Lyon.
2. Students selected must indicate they are in need of financial assistance in order to pursue further and higher education.
3. Scholarship recipients are free to attend the institution of higher learning of their choice. No restrictions are made as to the school you can attend.
4. Scholarships are a one-time award and will be distributed by the West Lyon School Foundation on September 1st.

Scholarship applications are in Miss Mulder’s office. **Deadline is Tues, March 28.**

The Lloyd Anderson Trust Scholarship – upon the passing of Lloyd Anderson, a trust was created according to his wishes to help West Lyon graduates obtain some financial assistance for higher education. Applicants must show average diligence in their studies and be in need of financial assistance for further education. Application forms can be found in Miss Mulder’s office (this is part of a joint application form). **Deadline is Tues, March 28.**

The Melvin Serck Estate Scholarship - Melvin Serck was a kind and generous man who grew up and lived out his life in the Alvord area. Within his Last Will and Testament, Mr. Serck made arrangements to fund two annual scholarships for needy students (one for a boy and one for a girl) graduating from West Lyon School so that they might attend a post high school education institution. Applicants must show honest effort in their studies at West Lyon and have a need for financial assistance to further their education. Each Scholarship will be in the amount of between \$1,000 to \$1,500. Applications can be found in Ms. Mulder's office (this is part of a joint application form). **Deadline is Tues, March 28.**

Harding Family Scholarship - Sharon Sharlepp endowed trust to honor her ancestors, O.B. and Emiline Harding and their son, W.L. Harding. The purpose of this trust is to provide educational opportunities and financial assistance to young adults from Osceola, Lyon, Sioux and O'Brien counties of Iowa. Scholarships range from \$500-900. Application forms can be found in Miss Mulder's office. (this is part of a joint application form). **Deadline is Tues, March 28.**

Luella Vosburg Estate Scholarship – Luella Vosburg was a kind and generous woman who supported education and West Lyon. Her estate has provided for a scholarship in memory of Luella for students who plan to go on to further education after high school. One boy and one girl will be selected to receive \$1,000 each. Application forms can be found in Miss Mulder's office. (this is part of a joint application form). **Deadline is Tues, March 28.**

West Lyon Athletic Booster Scholarship - This scholarship is from the West Lyon Athletic Booster Club for \$250 second semester freshman year in college. This scholarship will be awarded to a senior guy and a senior girl who has at least a 3.0 GPA and has participated in a minimum of two sports per year, for four years, but will not be receiving an athletic scholarship for collegiate sports. **Deadline is April 1.**

West Lyon Education Association Scholarship – West Lyon seniors who are planning to pursue a degree in the area of education are invited to apply for the WLEA scholarship that is awarded annually. **Deadline is Friday, April 7.**
