Just a couple of reminders for families as we get into the school year. Please pass on to others in the community as possible.

1)Outdoor school facilities are reserved for school use only and closed to the public during the school day and when being used by school teams or groups after school. This includes all fields,

the track, the elementary playground, and the school woods. Please feel free to enjoy these spaces outside of school hours when school groups are not using them.

2)The use of Smart Watches and Cell Phones. The use of these are prohibited during the school day. If students have these items they need to be in their backpack the whole day and may not be used without teacher or administrator approval. Due to capabilities with pictures and other communication happening from these devices, this is both a privacy and a safety issue within the building and on transportation. **This includes the School Buses.** If they are out during the day including recess, they will be brought to the office until the end of the day. If the incidences continue they will be held in the office and a call for parents to pick them up will be made. With all things, lost or damaged devices are not covered by the school. It is best if able to leave these items at home, if needed they should stay in the students backpack.



We are having the challenge of filling a number of supervisory positions at the school that are all important. We have also for a long time staffed some positions off campus as a courtesy to the community. It is our desire to be able to continue this practice, but we don't have the human power to cover all of the positions needed at the building and at various spots all the time where there has been someone in the past. As often as possible we will cover these areas, namely crosswalking spots by Jefferson/Knowledge Road. In a number of schools these are volunteer positions run by community members wanting to help out for a few minutes. With that in mind, we are interested in finding either parent, grandparent, or community member(s) who would be interested in partnering with us to ensure these areas are filled on a daily basis. At this time we are seeking a Morning (AM) person to assist on days we do not have people to cover on a regular basis, which are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday mornings.
