203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure consistency in the order of business at regular school board meetings.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school board to consider matters that come before it in a consistent and orderly manner.

III. ORDER

- A. The school board shall conduct an orderly school board meeting. The school board will, at all regular school board meetings, follow an agenda order similar to:
 - 1. Call to Order.
 - 2. Approval of Agenda. The school board may revise the agenda with the consent of the majority of the members present.
 - 3. Visitors' Communication
 - 4. Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes.
 - 5. Approval of Regular District Bills.
 - 6. Approval of Special District Bills
 - 7. Treasurer's Report
 - 8. Recognitions
 - 9. Cabinet Communications (including Customer Compliment, Concern, Complaints)
 - 10. Student Board Member Report & Communication
 - 11. Reports
 - 12. Old Business
 - 13. New Business
 - a. Any New Business Items
 - b. Consent Accept Resignations
 - c. Consent Hires
 - d. Consent Accept Donations
 - 14. Hearing of Reports
 - a. Superintendent's Report & Communication
 - b. Board of Education Committee Reports & Communication
 - 15. Adjournment
- B. Items in this order may be considered as part of a consent agenda.
