

High School Course Syllabus

Course Name: College Calculus I (Full Year) –Elective course offered thru SMSU
College Credit: 5 College credits thru SMSU (must qualify for these thru SMSU requirements)
Instructor: Mr. Wawrzyniak
Office Hours: 7:30-8:00 and 3:00-3:30, other times by appointment
Grade Level: 11 - 12
Prerequisite: Successful completion of Pre Calculus
Objective: The following topics will be covered:
Limits, Derivatives, Integrals (definite and indefinite), Antiderivatives,
Parametric Functions, Exponential and Logarithmic Functions, Growth and
Decay, Maximums and Minimums, Surface Area, Volume, etc.

Grading Information:

1. Assignments – Assignments will be collected. These will be worth 5 points each. The amount you earn will depend on how much of the assignment is completed. An assignment is completed if all assigned problems are done on time with work shown neatly and in an organized manner. Completed assignments will earn full credit. Assignments with missing work or problems will be given partial credit. Assignments with little to no work or just answers will be considered incomplete and given a zero. Please print the assignment at the top of your paper with your name. All homework is due on test day.
Late Work Policy: All late work is due within 7 days of the assignment due date for possible full credit on the assignment. Any work turned in after one week from the due date will receive one point. Any missing work will be marked as a zero in the gradebook until the work is turned in and graded. Any work that is not turned in will remain a zero.
2. Calculators – You will be permitted to use calculators on homework. I usually do not allow them on tests or quizzes.
3. Quizzes – They will generally cover a few sections. Most quizzes are announced.
4. Tests – All tests are announced. They usually cover 3 or 4 sections from the book.
5. Retakes – You will have the opportunity to retake each test or quiz one time for high school grade only. There are no retakes for college score. The maximum score you can receive on the retake is 85%. You will have one week from when the test or quiz is handed back to you to complete the retake.
6. Extra Credit – None
7. Cheating will not be tolerated. If caught, you will receive ZERO credit on that material. Refer to high school student handbook for further consequences.
8. Your grade will be weighted 15% Homework, 85% Tests/Quizzes

Rules, etc:

1. Consider this class to be a job where you are required to be here every school day.

7. Calculators – you will probably want one for homework. You do not need a graphing calculator, but if you want one. – TI 83 or TI 84 is preferred.
8. DO NOT play games on your calculators during class!
9. You will need a 3-Ring Binder for the handouts and a separate notebook for this class.
10. Fire and Tornado drills – Where do we go?
11. Desks – not to be used as garbage cans or to be written on.
12. Tardies – You will be counted tardy if you are not in your assigned seat when the bell begins to ring.
13. Bathroom – When?
14. Passes will only be given with planner with your name on it.
15. No eating or drinking in class unless given permission. Water is O.K.
16. Student handbook items – Clothing, **NO Cell Phones in classroom (leave it in your locker)**, Cheating, Absences, etc.
17. Make-up work – You, the student, are responsible for finding out the assignments and completing them on a timely basis. If a test or quiz is taken on the day you are absent then you need to coordinate with the Teacher when this is to be made up. It will be listed as a zero in the gradebook until completed.
18. Book Covers – Must be on the book by Friday, Sept. 11.
19. I reserve the right to “modify” any of the rules or add new rules to better suit the learning situation in this classroom.
