November is here so that means a new focus ticket! In November, the elementary and high school will have the same focus: **Positive Participation in Class.**



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Positive participation in class can be shown in many different ways. Here are some examples:

- answering the teacher's questions in class discussions
- building on another student's answer in a discussion
- actively participating in "turn and talks" or small group discussions
- and many more.

NEWS FROM PRINCIPAL LEE:

Consistent attendance is vital to vour child's education. A student is considered habitually

absent when he or she missing more than 10% of the school year for any reason. Here is a simple breakdown to figure out if you child falls into the habitually absent category:

Absent more than: 4 times a quarter. 9 times in a semester. 18 times in a school year.

Appointments are another example on how students miss more school than they should. Try to make appointments outside the school day or during breaks in the school year to avoid excessive absences.

The vast majority of students are absent from school less than 5% of the year (less than 8 days).

Please be conscious of the number of days your child(ren) miss school.

extra time to talk with students about careers and colleges, and a door decorating contest.




