- Youth must reside in McLeod County and be enrolled in grades k-12. If younger, special review will be required.
- Acceptable organizations for youth activities: All organizations that provide positive role models, build self-esteem and skills development, to empower children by nurturing their talents, fostering their passions, and enhancing their social, emotional, and cognitive skills through participation in extracurricular activities.
- We will not provide scholarships for : Religious organizations/education or Drivers Ed. classes.
- Scholarship Year: August 1- July 31
- Maximum Scholarship per child/Year: \$300
- Scholarship amount per activity: up to 50% of total activity fee
- Application deadline: Applicants must turn in their scholarship application to the youth activity organization **prior** to the close of registration.
- UWMC will review applications and contact the organization with their decision. UWMC will send payment directly to the organization, who is responsible to provide scholarship information to applicant.
