Preschool Screening

Minnesota law states that each school district must offer a screening clinic before starting Kindergarten. This is called Early Childhood Developmental Screening. Lester Prairie School will provide this service at no cost for children ages 3 and older and have not been previously screened. We encourage you to come at a younger age.

Early Childhood developmental screening helps a school district identify children who may benefit from district and community resources available to help in their development. Early Childhood developmental screening includes a vision screening that helps detect potential eye problems but is not a substitute for a comprehensive eye exam. The screening takes about 45 minutes. The screening is required for school entrance.



