

Waconia Community Education – Player Agreement

Players' Code of Conduct:

- I will attend all scheduled practices and games unless I notify the coaches in advance.
- I understand that playing time in games is a privilege to be earned by my behavior regarding practice. I pledge to attend all practices and display a positive attitude and a strong effort in practice and games. I will practice and play hard.
- I will be respectful of my coaches and listen when I am spoken to.
- I will be a positive participant for my team, refraining from foul language and unsportsmanlike behavior
- I will respect the property and equipment of others, whether it is my teammates or others, at my home field or at another facility.
- I will be respectful of all team members, coaches, parents, officials and members of other teams. I will treat people as I would wish to be treated.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship and play the sport in a “clean” way
- I agree to abide by the policies of Waconia Community Education and other associations associated with the sport regarding sexual and physical abuse; anti-discrimination and alcohol, drugs and tobacco usage. I understand that I am responsible for my own actions and consequences of my actions on and off the baseball field. Therefore, I pledge to set a positive example of behavior in all settings (e.g., team membership, in the community, at school, etc.), and I will accept consequences when such behavior is compromised.
- I will be respectful of my teammates, coaches, and team parents and make every effort to make the sports experience a fun and positive experience.

Understanding: There will be a three strike rule for any violation of the above Code of Conduct.

If **COACHES** in their best judgement feel that a violation has occurred by any player they will report it to Waconia Community Education.

Community Education will review that violation and make a ruling as to whether the violation warrants a strike. Community Education is the **FINAL** say as to whether a player is penalized with a strike or not. Parents and players will be notified of strikes from their Head Coach and Community Education.

Violation Penalties (Are as follows but not limited to just the following)

- First Strike Penalty: Player will be benched for at least half a game. (Must attend the game for it to count)
- Second Strike Penalty: Player will be benched for 1 full game (Must attend the game for it to count)
- Third Strike Penalty: Player will be suspended indefinitely from team activities, Head Coach, Parents and Player must meet with Community Education in order to be considered for reinstatement.
