Waconia Community Education – Parent Agreement

Parent's Code of Conduct:

- I will place my child's emotional and physical well-being as my top priority
- I will remember that the game is for the children and not for the adults.
- I will encourage respect for the participants of the sport.
- I will be positive and supportive of each child's efforts, recognizing that each child is an individual and each possesses different skills and abilities.
- I will remember that the development of skills through practice and perseverance is more important than winning games.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support and behavior toward all players, coaches, officials and other parents/spectators at every game or practice.
- I will be responsible for dropping off and picking up my child on time, if I can not pick my child up on time I will arrange a ride for them or let the coach know ahead of time.
- I will come to the events drug and alcohol free.
- I will treat coaches, game officials and league officials with courtesy and respect before, during and after games.
- I will not undermine or question the coach's instructions, directions or decisions.
- I will place the realistic skill development of my child above my own personal expectations.
- I will stay out of the bench area before, during or after games and practices.
- I agree that I will support the emotional and physical well-being of all the participants on my child's team, ahead of any personal desire to win games or any desire for personal glory.

Understanding: :

There will be a three strike rule for any violation of the above Code of Conduct.

If <u>ANY PERSON</u>, whether part of the team or not, in their best judgement feel that a violation has occurred by any parent they will report it to Waconia Community Education.

Community Education will review that violation and make a ruling as to whether the violation warrants a strike. Community Education is the **<u>FINAL</u>** say as to whether a parent is penalized with a strike or not. Parents will be notified of strikes from Community Education. Violation Penalties (Are as follows but not limited to just the following)

First Strike Penalty: Parent will be suspended from attending the next of

- First Strike Penalty: Parent will be suspended from attending the next game and any practices/events leading up to that game.
- Second Strike Penalty: Parent will be suspended from attending half of the team's remaining games and any practices/events in that time frame.
- Third Strike Penalty: Parent will be suspended indefinitely from all team activities, Head Coach, and Parent plus any spouse/significant other must meet with Community Education in order to be considered for reinstatement.Could also result in suspension of all Community Education activities
