Lake City Preschool registration for the 2024-2025 school year will be based on a random lottery system. 3 year old and 4 year old registration forms can be picked up in the Bluff View and Community Education Offices or found online at [www.lake-city.k12.mn.us](http://www.lake-city.k12.mn.us) by clicking on the Community Education tab, then Lake City Preschool.

Registration form(s) must be put in the drop box in the Bluff View Elementary Office or mailed to the above address, along with a \$35 non-refundable registration fee, by Friday, March 1<sup>st</sup> before 4:00 p.m. ONE form per child, ONE envelope per family, with checks made payable to "I.S.D. 813". Cub Care registration forms are separate- and your child must be enrolled in preschool and toilet trained in order to attend.

Tuition for 2 day programming is \$123 per month

Tuition for 3 day programming is \$157 per month

Tuition for 5 day programming is \$235 per month

Children may qualify for scholarships based on family needs and income. Scholarship forms are also available in the office or online and must be completed and submitted before April 30, 2024. You will not be notified of a scholarship until after July 1, 2024.

Students currently enrolled in the 3 year old program will have registration priority and may drop off the registration form and fee to their child's teacher by Friday, February 16th before 12:30 p.m.

District registrations will be processed randomly. Out of district registrations will then be considered. Parents will be notified by mail of their child's placement no later than May 15. Questions can be directed to the Community Education Office at 651-345-7170. Please, **NO INQUIRIES TO PRESCHOOL CLASSROOMS REGARDING REGISTRATION.**

Transportation is not provided for preschool students through ISD 813. Parents may contact Hiawathaland Transit at 1-866-623-7505 regarding transportation needs.
