SUBJECT: Unified Team Participation State Track & Field Championships

The WIAA member schools and the state track & field meet management are excited to partner with Special Olympics of WA to offer a Unified Track opportunity at the 2024 State Track & Field meets in Yakima and in Tacoma. It is important that these athletes have an opportunity to compete in interscholastic activities within our schools. To this end it is imperative that each school sending a team take the time to make sure that each athlete/partner pair is eligible under the WIAA, Special Olympics of WA and school rules. All athletes are required to demonstrate compliance with those rules of eligibility in Article 18 of the WIAA Handbook and any corresponding school rules and regulations. Unified Sports® is an inclusive sports program that combines an approximately equal number of Special Olympics athletes (individuals with intellectual disabilities) and partners (individuals without intellectual disabilities) on teams for training and competition.

*Unified Athlete is a student who must be identified by an agency or professional as having one of the following conditions: Intellectual disabilities, cognitive delays as measured by formal assessment, or significant learning or vocational problems due to cognitive delay that require or have required specially designed instruction.

*Unified Parter may be any student without intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.

Unified relays teams are made up of 4 participants and must include two (2) Unified Athletes and two (2) Unified Partners. For the SMR, one (1) Unified Athlete must run one of the 100M legs of the relay.
