## doubling before a suffix

## Doubling before adding a suffix

When one vowel is followed by one consonant at the end of a one syllable word, the consonant is doubled before adding a suffix beginning with a vowel.

(Examples: 'big' to 'bigger', 'dim' to 'dimmed')

(The extra consonant is used to close first syllable, assuring a short vowel sound. [Example: not 'bi/ger' but 'big/ger'])
