Doubling before adding a suffix
When one vowel is followed by one consonant at the end of a one syllable word, the consonant is doubled before adding a suffix beginning with a vowel.

(Examples: 'run' to 'run/ner', 'stop' to 'stop/ping')

(The extra consonant is used to close first syllable, assuring a short vowel sound. [Example: not 'ru/ner' but 'run/ner'])
