The Board of Directors of Agassiz & Odessa Mutual Insurance Company has established a scholarship program to assist students in furthering their post-high school education. Agassiz & Odessa Mutual Insurance Company is offering two scholarships of \$500 each.

ELIGIBILITY:

- a.) Student must be a graduating high school senior.
- b.) The student's parent(s) must have an insurance policy in effect with Agassiz & Odessa Mutual Insurance Company at the time of the scholarship application.
- c.) Student will be attending a college, university or vocational/technical school and majoring in a two, three or four-year curriculum.
- d.) Interested students must complete the scholarship application form and forward it to the company office.

The two \$500 scholarships will be paid to the recipients at the beginning of his or her second semester/quarter of school. Failure to begin the second semester/quarter of studies will result in forfeiture of the scholarship. The announcement of the scholarship winner will be made at the respective school's Scholarship/Awards Ceremony.

The selection process will begin after the <u>application deadline of February 15, 2023</u>. The field of applicants will be narrowed down to five finalists. The selection will be made by the Scholarship Committee, which consists of four board members and the company manager.

During the selection process the Committee will not necessarily be looking just for the "straight-A" student. Strong consideration will be given towards student effort even though the student may only be getting B's and/or C's.

The Board of Directors of Agassiz & Odessa Mutual has made this an annual scholarship program. We would appreciate any recommendations that you may have to offer that might improve this program.

All students who are eligible for the Agassiz & Odessa Mutual Insurance Company Scholarship are also eligible for the Minnesota Association of Farm Mutual Insurance Companies (MAFMIC) Scholarship and must complete a separate application following the guidelines for that program and submit the application to our office.
