

### Kerkhoven **Farmers Market**



We have classes for 3-, 4-, and 5-year olds, as well as an option for a mixed age group. Students also have the opportunity to attend the Norwegian-infused preschool located in Sunburg.

Schedules vary, with students being able to attend two or four days. Please consider carefully what would work best for your student and your family—switching schedules mid-year may be difficult.

### **Tuition/Scholarships**

In addition to the regular rates, we are proud to offer different scholar-ship options that provide students with free tuition and the same quality classroom experience. Information and applications are available now. Contact Becky Carlson, KMS Preschool Coordinator, for more information at rcarlson@kms.k12.mn.us.

A nonrefundable \$25 deposit is due at the time of registration, regardless of whether you are expecting a scholarship. The registration fee after August 15, 2025 is \$50.

Rates have not been set for the 2025-26 school year but will be similar to the current prices:

4 days: \$340/month or \$3060/year 2 days: \$240/month or \$2160/year

### **Thrilling Threes, Kerkhoven**

(Child must be 3 by September 1, 2025)

A class for 3-year olds only! Children spend time learning about group dynamics, independence, self discipline, and developing social skills. Activities are fun so children are improving their pre-literacy skills and academics without even knowing it.

#### **Fantastic Fours, Kerkhoven**

(Child must be 4 by September 1, 2025)

This is just for the 4-year olds! Typically for children who have a year of preschool behind them, but could also be the first setting for 4-year olds who haven't yet attended. Continued encouragement to do things for themselves while learning to work together and prepare for kindergarten.

#### The Mighty Mix, Kerkhoven

(Child must be 3 by September 1, 2025)

A mutli-age group of 3 - 5 year olds. Elements of both the Threes and Fours classes are utilized. Younger students learn from older ones, while the older students model for those who are new to preschool. Students can experience the same teacher for two years, allowing familiarity and routine to build a comfortable foundation for learning.

### The Barnehage, Sunburg

(Child must be 3 by September 1, 2025)

We offer a multi-age classroom of 3 - 5 year olds based on preschools in Norway. In addition to traditional academic and social skills, students learn about the language and culture of Norway. Visits from the staff of Kultur Hus as well as baking, singing, crafting, and playing outside bring in many concepts carried out in Norwegian preschools.

### **Early Childhood Screening**

The early childhood years from birth to the start of kindergarten are an important time of rapid learning and growth. Between the ages of three and four screening can detect possible health or learning concerns so that children can get help before they start school. Children need to be screened within 60 days of starting preschool.

Screening provides an opportuity for young children and their families to access a wide variety of services and early childhood programs, and promotes and supports parents' understanding of their child's health, development, and learning.

Ideally children are screened between the ages of three and four. If your child has not yet been screened and you have not been contacted to make an appointment, please call Pat, Community Ed assistant, at 320-264-1979 to set up a time. The next early childhood screenings have tentatively been scheduled for:

### 2025 Swimming Lessons

**Level 1 –** Skills taught will include: Entering and exiting water safely, swimming on front and back using arms and legs, floating, going under water. It is easier if students can touch in the 3 foot end.

**Level 2 –** Skills taught will include: Front and backstroke legs, floating, rolling over from front to back, front and back glides.

**Level 3 –** Skills taught will include: Jumping into deep water, survival float, tread water using arm and leg motions, backstroke, dive from standing position, use rotary breathing, front crawl and back crawl.

**Level 4 –** Skills taught will include: Improve front and back crawl, scissor kick, breaststroke, swim underwater, and perform open turns.

**Level 5 –** Skills taught will include: Tread water with two different kicks, breaststroke kick, survival swimming, standing dive, front flip turns, tuck surface dive and sidestroke.

**Level 6 –** Skills taught will include: Improve all strokes and endurance, swim 500 yards, obtain an object in 10 feet of water.

**Private Lessons –** Contact the pool directly at 264-2222 for inquiries on availability—cost is \$90.
