- Constantly required to move and interact with students in and outside a swimming pool including standing, walking, sitting, stooping, bending, kneeling, pushing, pulling and reaching with hands and arms.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk, hear, lift, use hands for fingering, grasping and feeling, wrists, hands and/or fingers for repetitive motions or computer use.
- The employee must frequently lift, move and/or carry up to 30 pounds.
- The employee is occasionally required to lift and/or move up to and over 30 pounds.
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, and the ability to adjust focus.
