The Swim Instructor/Lifeguard is responsible for teaching swimming basics to community members and maintaining a safe and healthy swimming pool environment.

4.	Supervises the general care of pool and outdoor equipment. a) Repairs equipment when needed. b) Instructs students of the proper use of equipment.
