104 SCHOOL DISTRICT MISSION STATEMENT

Adopted:January 5, 2004Last Revised:August 5, 2024

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a clear mission statement for the school district.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. The school district's mission statement should be based on the values and beliefs of the whole community, should direct any change effort, and should be used to help guide decisions.
- B. The school board, on behalf of and with extensive participation by community members, should develop a consensus regarding the nature of the enterprise the school board governs, the purpose it serves, the constituencies it should consider, including student representation, and the results it intends to produce.

III. MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Red Wing Public Schools is to educate and inspire all students as they realize their full potential and become respectful, responsible, and productive citizens.

IV. REVIEW

The school board will review the school district's mission every three years. The school board will conduct a comprehensive review of the mission, including the beliefs and values of the community, every five to seven years.
