Who is Bob Jaszczak?

The district's new superintendent, Bob Jaszczak (pronounced Josh-ek), taught math for 16 years in the Lancaster and Kittson Central school districts, also serving as a coach, technology coordinator, and activities director. During this time, he also ran a livestock farm and briefly left education from 1998-2001 to run a restaurant and work in HVAC and appliance repair. Returning to education in 2001, Jaszczak transitioned into administration in 2008 as the superintendent at South Koochiching/Rainy River before spending 13 years at Kittson Central. He joined Red Wing after being unanimously selected by the School Board on April 15, officially starting on July 1.

School Board Chair Jim Bryant praised Jaszczak: "He is knowledgeable, hardworking, and respected across Minnesota. Most importantly, he's always focused on the students."



"The time I spent away from education was invaluable," Jaszczak said. "It ultimately made me a better superintendent."





Driver's Education Classroom

Classes are open to students aged 14 ½ years old (by the last day of the class session). Registration can be completed in person at the Community Education office located at Red Wing High School in the lower Jpod or online at rwps.org/cer under the Driver's Education tab.

Classroom training consists of 30 hours of instruction from a Driver's Education licensed teacher. Cost includes \$180 for classroom, \$220 for behind the wheel, or \$385 for both classroom and behind the wheel when paid together. 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Driver's Education Permit Test (Class D Knowledge Test), Ages 15+

The permit test is available to students that have taken driver's education classroom through Red Wing Community Education. Passing this test allows students to apply for their learner's permit. Students will take the test on a computer, proctored by a licensed instructor, and have up to 30 minutes to complete the test. Results are given immediately after completing your test. 

