What is ECFE?

ECFE classes are designed for all families with children ages birth to kindergarten enrollment. These classes offer a variety of learning opportunities for parents and their children. The Early Childhood Family Education classes offer play and learning activities appropriate for the age of the child, parent-child activities, and parent discussion groups.

ECFE recognizes that families are children’s first and most significant teachers and that families provide children’s first important learning environment. ECFE also helps children grow and develop, enriches family life, and provides information and support for your important role as a parent.

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Special Points of Interest:

The number of sessions and children allowed vary with classes—check each class to see how many sessions there are and the limit of children allowed in each class. **If there are more registrations than spaces available, a lottery system will be used to determine class participants.**

Sibling care is available during the Incredible Infants class & other parenting classes/events.

Infants age 6 months and younger may accompany parents in all other classes.

South Country Health Alliance members are eligible to participate in ECFE classes at no charge. Special Events are **NOT** covered by South Country.

No Red Wing resident will be denied participation in ECFE due to inability to pay. Participants may request a fee waiver. Payment and fee waiver information is confidential.

Registration Process

MAIL IN your registration form with payment of your choice at Colvill Family Center, 269 E. 5th St., Red Wing, MN 55066. Make checks payable to ECFE.

PHONE IN registrations are welcome. Call 385-8000 to register, Monday–Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Registration is on-going until classes fill.

How will I know if I got in the class? We will notify you ONLY if the class is full or cancelled. If you do not hear from us, you are in the class!

Health Information Forms: Minnesota law requires that schools maintain immunization records for all children attending classes (including ECFE classes). **Please provide copies of current immunization records BEFORE classes begin**

Class Refund/Cancellation Policy: Before the session begins, a full refund is issued for cancellations. After the first week, refunds are pro-rated. No refunds midway through classes. We may cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment one week before it is scheduled to begin.

South Country Alliance: Members are eligible to participate in ECFE at no charge (Colvill Play Days and Special Events are excluded). Child’s ID number is required.

Fee Waiver: No Red Wing resident will be denied participation due to inability to pay. Participants may request a fee waiver. Payment and/or waiver information is confidential.

Student/Parent Illness: ECFE will follow the Red Wing School District’s illness policies. Additional cleaning & sanitizing measures are in place.

ECFE Class Information

Updated immunization forms must be on file.

All Winter/Spring classes run for 13 weeks.

Use the age of your child at the start of the session to determine which class a child should attend.

The Winter/Spring session will begin on Thursday, January 8 and run through May 29.

Registrations will be processed on Tue., Jan. 6, using a lottery system.
