



Wrestling Bulletin

State Championship February 19, 2022

St. Albans School

I. General Information

- A. Wrestling NFHS rules will apply to the DCSAA Championship Meet unless otherwise noted.
- B. Schools choosing to enter the DCSAA Championship Meet have the responsibility for reading and adhering to the rules and regulations of this bulletin.
- C. Eligibility rules for all participants can be found in the new Chapter 27 (interscholastic Athletics) Title 5 of the DCMR.
- D. A wrestler, in order to qualify, must be on the active Wrestling roster of the school team by January 19, 2022, and must have participated in a minimum of one (1) Wrestling meet with the school's team.
- E. **Entries must be submitted via TrackWrestling by Thursday, February 17 and must include each athlete's weight class and results to date this season. The login information for this will be provided to all coaches on or around February 14.**

II. State Meet

A. Meet Organization

- 1. **Entry Deadline – 7 p.m., Thursday, February 17, 2022 – NO EXCEPTIONS.** Each DCSAA member school can enter as a team, with a maximum of one wrestler per weight class. There is no fee to enter the tournament. All weight certification criteria and other entry criteria must be satisfied prior to the state tournament.
- 2. The 2022 DCSAA Wrestling Championship will be held on Saturday, February 19.
- 3. There will be 14 different weight classes; no separate divisions for girls: 106, 113, 120, 126, 132, 138, 145, 152, 160, 170, 182, 195, 220 and 285 pounds, scratch +2.



4. In order to seed each weight class, the tournament administrator will conduct a virtual seeding meeting that includes the coaches of all participating teams on Friday, February 18 at 8 pm. Details for this meeting will be provided to all coaches following tournament registration.
5. Weigh-ins will take place by weight class on the day of the tournament at 7 a.m. Wrestling begins at 8:30 a.m.
6. A single-elimination main draw will determine the top two finishers in each weight class. Losers in the main draw prior to the weight class final will compete in a consolation bracket to determine third place. Wrestlers will earn team points for each victory toward the overall team competition.
7. DCSAA will provide officials for all matches. It is requested that each team provide volunteers to work the tables during matches.
8. Team scoring can be followed on TrackWrestling.
9. All place winners must wear school-issued uniform or warmups for awards and photos.

B. General Policies

1. Awards will be presented to the top four finishers in each weight class and to the top two teams.
2. Spectator admission: \$10. Children age 10 and under are free. Spectators will be able to leave the gym and return.
3. Each participating team will be given two wristbands for coaches' admissions. Additional coaches must pay to enter.
4. Spectators are permitted to videotape and take photographs from the stands; spectators cannot take video/photos from the competition floor.

C. First Aid/Medical

1. Certified Athletic Trainers will be at the event to assist with any medical emergencies.

D. Disqualification



1. Undesirable behavior on the part of the school participants or nonparticipants shall be grounds for disqualification, at the determination of DCSAA staff and the tournament administrator. Failure to comply will result in disciplinary action.
