## Kindergarten at Milaca Elementary

Milaca Elementary is highly committed to meeting the unique needs of your child. Milaca Kindergarten is a free all day-every day program. Students will have lunch and recess time, attend music, art, phy-ed, and media classes, and will receive free milk for their snack break each school day. Parents will be notified during the school year about potential opportunities to volunteer.



## Kids Town

Kids Town is a before and after school care program for students in grades PreK – 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Morning hours are 6:30 AM to 8:00 AM. Afternoon hours are 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM. ## Health

## Busing and Transportation

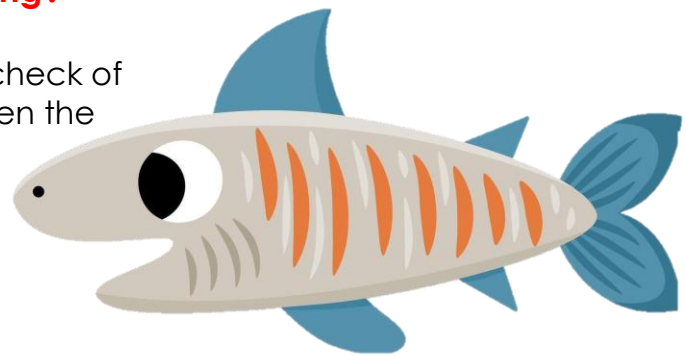
All students that live in the Milaca School District are eligible for bus transportation to and from school at no cost. Families will be contacted in July to sign up for transportation. Bus companies will contact families at the end of August. They will let you know what bus your child will be riding, pick up time, and drop off time.



## Need to schedule an Early Childhood Screening? Do you have any questions?

Early Childhood Screening is a quick and simple check of how your child is growing and developing between the ages of three and four years. Early Childhood Screening is required by the State of Minnesota for every child entering Kindergarten.
