

Third Grade Expectations

Enter and leave the classroom quietly and in an orderly manner. Remember, we are in a learning environment.

You are responsible for your planner. It is a very important link between home and school. Show your planner to your parents every night and discuss what you did during the day and what homework you have. After your homework is completed, have your parents sign your planner. If you don't have homework, you must still show your parents your planner and have it signed. You must bring your planner, signed, to class every day. You can earn Wolf Paws from your classroom teacher for having a signed planner. If you forget your planner, there may be a fine of Wolf Paws per day.

When the 8:15 bell rings, you should be in your seat, ready for learning. You will be counted tardy (late) if you arrive after the 8:15 bell. If you are tardy you must stop at the office and get a pass into class. An exception to this might be if your school bus is late. You should have 2 sharpened lead pencils ready for work every day before morning announcements. Times you may sharpen pencils include: •before morning announcements, during milk break, before noon recess, or before Recess.

Raise your hand to ask/answer questions, make comments, or to request permission to leave your desk. BLURTING is NOT an option.

When using the restroom, be responsible and respectful. Go into the bathroom quietly, do your business, wash your hands, and clean up after yourself (paper towels go into the garbage).

In our hallways and school spaces, walk with line basics: hands to yourself, facing forward in a line, and walking quietly.

Respect of classmates, teachers, helpers and school property is expected. This includes using a respectful manner in your speech and actions throughout the day. The school's discipline plan, found in your planner, outlines consequences for disrespect.
