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Athletic Registration Procedure for Non-Public School Students **Twin Valley School District (TVSD)**

Purpose

In accordance with the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) ruling, the Twin Valley School District (TVSD) shall permit eligible students who reside within the Twin Valley School District boundaries but attend a charter school, cyber charter school, private school or private faith based school to try out for and participate in TVSD interscholastic athletic programs, provided all eligibility and registration requirements are met.

Eligibility

To be eligible for participation, a student must:

- Reside within the Twin Valley School District attendance area, and
- Attend a charter school, cyber charter school, private school or private faith based school that does not offer the requested interscholastic athletic program, and
- Meet all PIAA, TVSD, and team-specific eligibility requirements.

Registration and Participation Requirements

Prior to tryouts or participation in any TVSD athletic program, the following requirements must be completed and verified:

1. Letter of Interest

The student or parent/guardian must submit a written letter of interest to the TVSD Athletic Director indicating the student's intent to try out for a specific athletic team.

2. Guidance Department Registration

The student-athlete must be registered with the Twin Valley School District Guidance Department to ensure academic eligibility tracking and compliance with PIAA requirements. This registration shall include, but not be limited to, submission and verification of accurate student transcripts, immunization records, and verification of the student's home address. 3. Student Central Registration

The student-athlete must be registered in **Student Central**, including completion of all required athletic forms, physicals, and acknowledgments, in accordance with district and PIAA guidelines.

4. Residency Verification

The student's home address must be verified to confirm residency within the Twin Valley School District boundaries. Acceptable documentation shall be determined by the district.

5. Ongoing Eligibility Verification

It shall be the responsibility of the non-public school in which the student is enrolled to contact the Twin Valley School District Athletic Department on a weekly basis to confirm the student-athlete's academic and eligibility status. Failure to provide weekly eligibility confirmation may result in the student-athlete's removal from the team until such verification is received.

6. Daily Attendance Verification

It shall be the responsibility of the non-public school in which the student is enrolled to contact the Twin Valley School District Athletic Department if the student is absent from school. Failure to provide daily attendance confirmation may result in the student-athlete's inability to participate on that day.

7. Transportation

It shall be the sole responsibility of the student-athlete's family to arrange transportation to and from Twin Valley School District facilities for all practices, meetings, and home contests. The Twin Valley School District will provide transportation from Twin Valley to away contests in accordance with district transportation policies.

All student-athletes are expected to arrive on time for all team activities, including practices, meetings, and competitions, as required of all team members. Failure to meet attendance and punctuality expectations may result in disciplinary action consistent with team and district policies.

Final Approval

Participation is contingent upon final approval by the Athletic Director after all requirements have been satisfied and verified. Failure to complete any required step may result in denial of tryout or participation privileges.

Compliance

All participating student-athletes are subject to Twin Valley School District policies, team rules, codes of conduct, and PIAA regulations for the duration of their participation.
